Rules (the Rules of DKV / WKF / ESKA / WSKA will be applied)

Kata

In Kata Competition ESKA Rules will be applied.

- Male/female separated
- Flag system for eliminations (Kata Individual)
- Score system until victory (Kata Team)
- All competitors need a red and a blue belt of their own
- Minimum grade: 6th Kyu (green belt)

Kata Individual

Until 16 competitors left the Kata will be chosen and announced by the chief judge: Heian Nidan, Heian Sandan, Heian Yondan, Heian Godan, Tekki

Flagg system will be applied - both contestants perform at the same time.

1st and 2nd place qualify for ESKA / WSKA Cup (applies only for group A and B)

Until 8 competitors left the Kata will be chosen and announced by the chief judge: Bassai Dai, Jion, Enpi, Kanku-Dai

Flagg system will be applied - both contestants perform at the same time.

Until 4 competitors left the Kata will be chosen and announced by the competitor: Bassai Dai, Jion

Enpi, Kanku-Dai

Score system will be applied – the 8 competitors perform one after the other.

At the finals the Kata will be chosen and announced by the competitor:

Free choice of Kata

Score system will be applied – the 4 competitors perform one after the other.

Kata Team as from 16 years

During eliminations (until 4 teams left) and finals the Kata will be chosen and announced by the competitors:

Free choice of Kata

Score system will be applied – the teams perform one after the other, no Bunkai needed.

- Male/female separated
- Elimination system with repechage
- All competitors need a red and a blue belt of their own
- Minimum grade: 5th Kyu (blue belt)

Kumite Individual

Group E and F Seniors as from 45 years DKV Competition Rules will be applied.

Kumite Individual Open

- only group C and D
- male / female separated
- Shobu Ippon without repechage According to the ESKA Competition Rules
- 1st and 2nd Place qualify for ESKA / WSKA Cup

Kumite Team

Group K and L

Seniors male/female as from 2002 and older 3 competitors per team plus two reserves

Duration of the Bout

Kumite Seniors Male 3 Min. Cadets, Juniors and Female 2 Min. Masters Female and Male 2 Min.

Referees and Judges

Invitations will be issued by Deutscher Karate Verband e. V.. Licensed Referees and Judges of international federations are welcome (they have to register via Sportdata!). The deployment will be done by the Chief Judge Roland Lowinger.

Protective Equipment

- Red/blue mitts
- Gum shield obligatory
- Groin guard for male competitors (if worn, they must conform with WKF rules)
- Chest protector for female competitors
- Shin pad and foot protection are allowed, not for open class.
